DESTINATIONS - Where in the World did they go?

Four Fields in the Analysis section are designed to help analyse world wide spread of the Cornish Diaspora. A geographical search may be focused on a region or a country or a State or even just a town.

Over the centuries country boundaries and names have altered. Whilst we have followed as far as possible the geographical region and country list used in the United Nations Country Grouping we have found it necessary to compile our own listing.

The CGMP have divided the world into twelve geographical regions. A search within the *Region* field should reveal all those records associated with that region. In a similar manner a search within the *Country* field will find records associated with a particular country.

See below the list of regions and countries within those regions.

It has been necessary to devise some conventions that not everyone will agree with. The database recognises Cornwall as a separate country within the region we call the British Isles. In a similar way Ireland (both the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland) are treated as being one country within the region of the British Isles.

A more detailed (Micro) geographic search may be performed using *State County* or the *Town*. These are limited in their usefulness. We may not have the information to fill a field and people moved from country to country and internally within countries.

Decisions

Which geographical category to place a record can be problematic. Linear Migrants can easily be identified. In other migrant categories we tend to use the place where the migrant died or spent the most time.

Field *Birth - Countries - Death* is a list of country movements starting with the birth country, through country travels and ending in the country of death. This is only completed when we know the birth and death places. This field is most useful when deciding the migrant category.

PLACE NAMES - ABBREVIATIONS

In the early years of our project it was customary to enter the states and territories of the USA, Canada and Australia in their 'official' abbreviated form. These can be confusing to those unfamiliar and even lead to mistakes. They are not intuitive! *For instance*, SA could be South Australia or South America, CA could be Central America or California, WA Western Australia or Washington. As far as possible abbreviations no longer appear in the CGMP Database but, as they often appear in sources we access, they are listed below for reference.
